Registration Fees: Registration fees are due by September 1st. In addition to the registration fee, swimmers will need to pay \$100 for their USA swimming membership. New families will be given instructions on how to do this at the parent meetings.

Tuition Fees: Monthly tuition payment will be charged to the credit card on file on the last of the month for September, October, November, December, January, February, and March. Monthly fees MUST be paid by the last of the month, or swimmers will be unable to continue to participate in practice or meets until fees have been paid. Swimmers also have the option of doing meets for an additional \$50 per month.

High School Fees: High school will not be charged for the months they are practicing with their high school team instead of the Barracudas. For fall athletes, they will be charged for December, January, February, and March. For winter athletes, they will be charged for September, October, November, and March.

Who we are:

The Greater Lowell YMCA Barracuda Swim Team is both a YMCA as well as a USA swim team. We incorporate all YMCA philosophies, while promoting the core values: caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. The Barracuda Swim Team is dedicated to helping swimmers improve their swimming skills, achieve their goals, and demonstrate the core values. We strive to encourage a lifetime involvement in sports and physical activity, as well as teaching the importance of being a team player.

Our team spans ages 5-18 and covers all levels of competitive swimming. The season typically competes in four dual meets (both home and away) against other YMCA's in our region, and four local USA Swimming meets. From the last week of January through the end of season, we have our Championship Meets.

All members of the Barracuda Swim Team are required to be full members of the Greater Lowell YMCA (per league rules). Minimum requirements for the team are at least five years of age and able to swim 25 yards front crawl and 25 yards back crawl (subject to coaches' approval). Depending on the level of the swimmer, practices run between 3-6 days a week.

Placement:

Placement is based on technique, endurance, and emotional development. The coaching staff will work with the swimmers and parents to ensure each child is in the best group for him or her. Coaches will work with swimmers to improve their technique and endurance. Placement days and times are below:
