## **GMNY SWIM TEAM ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT**

#### Expected Behavior as a GMNY Swim Team Athlete:

- I will conduct myself in a manner consistent with the character, welfare, best interests and policies of The Greater Monmouth YMCA.
- I will act and conduct myself with dignity and respect for others and the property of others.
- I will show respect for coaches, parents, officials, volunteers, spectators, and fellow athletes in all situations.
- I will promote a positive attitude in practice and always exhibit good sportsmanship.
- I will promote positive team spirit and morale.
- I will support my peers and encourage them in a positive manner during practice, meets, and everywhere we go.
- I will serve as a role model and mentor to young athletes in our program and others.
- Win or lose, I will offer congratulations to my opponents and support my teammates.
- I will represent myself, my family, and The Greater Monmouth YMCA in an exemplary manner.
- I will be a goodwill ambassador for our team and the sport of Swimming.

### **Prohibited Behavior at Team Events:**

- Use of alcoholic beverages.
- Use of illegal drugs or improper use of prescription medications.
- Vaping, smoking or other use of tobacco products.
- Destructive behavior.
- Inappropriate or unruly behavior, including failure to adhere to team standards and the GMNY Swim Team Member Code of Conduct.
- Swimmers of opposite sex are not permitted in each other's room or floor

# On Travel Trips or at any Swim Meet or GMNY Activity:

- The athlete must obey the curfews and room restrictions as determined by the coaching staff.
- The athlete must attend all team meetings.
- The athlete must wear the designated team uniform.
- Prescription medication is the responsibility of the Athlete, his/her parent(s)/legal guardian, and physician. The coaching staff must be notified in advance of any condition or medication that could affect the health, safety, and performance of the athlete.
- The athlete and parent(s)/legal guardian understand and agree that coaches reserve the right to search rooms and bags of athletes at any time at the discretion any coach.

### In Preparation for Departure on a Team Travel Trips:

- Coaches will provide a checklist of items to pack if requested
- Parent(s)/legal guardian will ensure that their child's bags do not contain any illegal items or substances in violation of this Code of Conduct.

#### Possible Consequences for Violation(s) of this Code of Conduct:

- An athlete may be removed from an event or swimming session for a violation of the Code of Conduct without refund
  of event fees.
- Any damaged or missing objects billed to a hotel room are the responsibility of the athletes in that room.
- Eliminating all non-swimming privileges during the trip.
- Sending the athlete home ahead of schedule. Any expenses associated with sending an athlete home ahead of schedule is to be borne by the athlete and his/her parent(s)/legal guardian. This includes but is not limited to hotel expenses, commuting expenses, and supervisory expenses.
- Temporary or permanent dismissal from the GMNY Swim Team without refund of fees associated with membership on the GMNY Swim Team.
- Possible dismissal from The Greater Monmouth YMCA premises and possible revocation of membership and/or usage privileges.
