- I understand criticizing, name-calling, use of inappropriate language or gestures which are directed at any coaches, officials, volunteers or swimmers will not be tolerated.
- I will follow all YMCA policies while utilizing the YAKIMA FAMILY YMCA.
- I will respect the YYST coaches and YAKIMA FAMILY YMCA personnel in my words and actions.
- Any concerns regarding YYST coaches or its operations should be addressed with the Aquatics Director.
- I will refrain from any discussions that do not support YYST, nor align with the YAKIMA FAMILY YMCA Core Values and Mission, at any YYST/IES/USA Swimming function.
