- **Opens September 1**. Please do not submit before September 1. You will have to resubmit.
- Team registration- \$50/year. Coach registration- Free until December 1, then \$25 per coach.
- Refer to the <u>YMCA Registered Coach Certifications</u> document for coach registration requirements and accepted training courses and providers.
- Refer to the TeamUnify <u>YMCA Registration articles</u> for assistance.
- If you have a coach listed with your team who is no longer with your team, please remove him or her. If you have switched to another YMCA, you will need to be removed from your previous YMCA team before registering with your new team. Save your certifications first. # Last Call: Submit Long Course Meet Results for YMCA Top 10/16

- SwimCloud is tabulating the YMCA Top 10/16 for 2021-22. Submit meet results to SwimCloud by emailing them to <u>results@swimcloud.com</u>; or upload the meet result directly to the meet in SwimCloud using your SwimCloud account; or export the meet results directly from Meet Manager 7 or higher by selecting File->Export->Results for SwimCloud.
- **Important**: Age is calculated as of first day of the meet for National Records and Top 10/16 recognition. Ensure that meet results are uploaded with that age designation in the results file.

# **YMCA Fall Virtual Invitational**

- Meet information will be posted on the YMCA Swimming and Diving website soon.
- Meets are held locally and results submitted for national tabulation of results. Local
  meets may be held **between September 30 and October 30**. Teams in states in
  which Y meet participation is restricted during High School season may hold their
  meet between November 25 and December 11.
- Counts as 1 closed YMCA inter-association meet as long as it is a closed YMCA meet (Y teams only) and the minimum number of YMCA officials are used.
- <u>Do not alter</u> the meet file in any way, or results will not be included.
