YMCA National Championships - Did You Know?

In the 3rd YMCA National Swimming and Diving Championship meet held on April 3-4, 1925, Walter Spence began his legacy. Walter Spence was born and raised in the jungle near Christiansburg, British Guyana. He learned how to swim in rivers and streams near his home while also avoiding being bitten by piranhas. After years of competitive swimming in British Guyana, he decided to come to the United States at age 22 where he swam for the Brooklyn Central YMCA. In his first YMCA National meet in Cincinnati, Ohio, he set two records - in the 440 yard freestyle and the 200 yard breaststroke. Spence was able to lift his team to a win over the Central Parkway Branch (Cincinnati, OH).



YMCA Top 16 Lists for 2021-22 Now Posted

The Top 16 is calculated through meet results submitted to SwimCloud. Age is determined by the swimmer's age on the first day of a meet, regardless of how a meet is formatted.

A swimmer must be a member of, and representing, a registered YMCA team in order to be included in the YMCA Top 16.

Ft. Lauderdale Aquatic Center Will Host YMCA National Masters Meet and YMCA National Diving Championship Meet

In 100 years of YMCA Swimming and Diving Championship Meets, Ft. Lauderdale has hosted 34 times, more than any other location. After a three year renovation, the Ft. Lauderdale Aquatic Center re-opened in September and will host both of these YMCA events this spring.
