Awards for Swimmers and Coaches

YMCA Swimming Coach of the Year

Coaches, parents and any YMCA staff may nominate a coach for the annual YMCA Coach of the Year Award, which recognizes significant and sustained impact on youth, the YMCA and their community. The award is presented at the 2024 YMCA National Short Course Championship Meet but recipients need not be present to be selected. <u>Nominations</u> and all supporting documents are due March 15.

Adolph Kiefer YMCA Youth Character Award

This award is presented to two YMCA swimmers at the 2024 YMCA National Short Course Swimming Championships. It also features \$2,500 in scholarship funds paid directly to each swimmer's college or university, thanks to the generous support of the Adolph Kiefer Family Foundation. Applications open February 1 and close March 1. <u>Application information and link</u> are on the YMCA Swimming and Diving site.

All Short Course Sanction Requests Now Past Due

Requests for YMCA meet sanctions are due 60 days prior to the first day of the meet. The YMCA National Short Course Swimming Championship Meet entry deadline is March 25. Any requests for sanctions for 2023-24 short course season meets are now late.

YMCA Swim Officials Tests

YMCA Swim Officials course tests are now available <u>only</u> through the LCDC and are taken online after completing a YMCA Swim Officials course.

Certification is issued after successful completion of the course and the test.

YMCA Swim Officials courses may be taught in person or virtually.
