YMCA National Long Course Championship Meet

- Entry deadline Monday, July 11 at 9:00 pm ET. Submit entries through <u>SwimCloud</u>.
- Applications for <u>Travel Assistance</u> are due by **Thursday, June 30**.
- Reminders for Coaches:
 - <u>Update or register</u> all coaches by **Friday**, **July 1** to be eligible to be on deck at the meet. Ensure all certifications are current through July 23.
 - Check that your YMCA's <u>Certificate of Insurance</u> is current on file with Y-USA.
 - <u>Attestations</u> (electronically signed forms required for each coach, parent of 17&U athlete, athlete age 18&O, volunteer and CEO/ED) are available on the website now. You may begin having these completed. They are due by
