Team and Coach Registration Update

The annual team and coach registration process provides valuable information on the size and scope of YMCA competitive swimming across the country including number or teams and coaches, team size, facilities used, league affiliation and seasonal structure. It also gives coaches access to email updates and provides.

As of June 1, 2023, there are 531 YMCA teams and 1,795 YMCA coaches registered. Of the teams registered, there are a reported 57, 929 swimmers participating across the country. Of the registered teams 54.24% are also members of USA Swimming.

National Advisory Committee Update

The YMCA National Swimming and Diving Advisory Committee is in the final stages of developing a Leading Practices guide for competitive swimming programs and coaches. It will offer best practices, leading practices and tips for coaches and YMCA in support of a successful program. The guide should be ready in the third quarter of 2023.
