YMCA National Short Course Championship News

- <u>Senior Recognition</u> submissions deadline is **March 15**. These will be featured on the video board at the meet. Include athlete's name, YMCA, plans after graduation and photo.
- <u>Coach of the Year</u> nominations deadline is **March 20**. Direct link <u>here</u>. The award is presented at the YMCA National Short Course Championship Meet but the recipient is not required to attend the meet.
- <u>Travel Assistance Application</u> deadline is **March 24**, but coaches of athletes seeking assistance are encouraged to apply early.
- <u>Athlete Volunteers</u> are needed to offer devotions and/or perform the National Anthem.
- Timers are needed. Sign-up link <u>here</u>. More information is found on the <u>meet web page</u>. Timers who work at least 4 meet sessions will receive free spectator admission to the other meet sessions.
- A *Moment of Remembrance* will be observed at the meet to recognize those from our YMCA Swimming family who have passed away since March 2022. Submit names and connection to YMCA Swimming to <u>Bob McDowell</u>.
- <u>On-site Dinners</u> are available for teams and swimmers at the Greensboro Aquatic Center-Special Events Center after Finals each evening. This is a quick and convenient way to eat a healthy hearty meal after Finals. Information is posted on the meet page.

YMCA National Championships – Did You Know?

In 1967, the first-ever Women's YMCA National Swimming and Diving Championship was held on April 25-27 at the Jordan Branch YMCA in Indianapolis, IN. With guidance from the YMCA National Swimming

Committee, along with Margaret "Peggy" Kelso, the meet featured 50 YMCA women's swim teams that competed in 17 individual and relay events. The first women's national champion was Chris Bernsen of the Ferguson-Ritenour Branch YMCA (St. Louis, MO), who won the 500 yard Freestyle with a time of 5:50.60. The Ferguson-Ritenour team was coached by Head Coach <u>Penny Taylor</u>, a 1948 Olympian and multi-time U.S. National Champion who later coached Olympian Tom Jager. Taylor's FRY team won the meet with a score of 65 points.

Y-USA Youth Advisory Council

Y-USA is launching a national Youth Advisory Council that will inform national leaders and the Board of Directors on issues and interests important to youth and teens. The council will have twenty members, ages 15-24, who will serve through 2023 with an option to continue through 2024. The council will have representation from all segments of Y youth and teen programming, including competitive sports. Current and former Y swimmers who are interested in being part of a national council, networking and governance are encouraged to apply. Most meetings will be virtual but an inaugural in-person meeting will occur at the YMCA General Assembly, July 20-23 in Atlanta. <u>Applications</u> are being accepted through March 31.

Submit Meet Results for Top 16

Remember to submit your meet results to SwimCloud. YMCA Top 16 is tabulated from results submitted through SwimCloud. Please remember that Top 16, like National Records, use the age of swimmers on the first day of the meet.

Competitive Sports Branding Webinar
