Submit Team and Coach Registrations by December 1.

Use <u>this link</u> to submit annual YMCA Team and Coach Registrations. After Dec. 1, coach registrations will be \$25 per coach. Only registered and approved coaches will receive national and regional information via e-mail after Dec. 1.

- Refer to the <u>Required Certifications for Coach Registration</u> document to be sure that your certifications meet the YMCA standards and will be accepted.
- Remember that BLS or Professional Rescuer CPR is required and must be renewed annually.
- Once registered and approved, remember to update certifications when they expire during the year. There is no charge for updating and resubmitting a coach registration. Coaches with expired certifications may not be permitted on deck at YMCA sanctioned meets.
- Team and coach registration is required for participation in any YMCA sanctioned meet.

Submit Results for YMCA Annual Tom Warrick Virtual Meet.

- Remember to use the standard meet file and event order provided for the meet. Refer to the <u>meet</u> <u>page</u> for more information.
- In states where participation in Y meets is restricted during the Fall High School Swimming season, alternate meet dates are Nov. 25-Dec. 11.
- Deadline to submit all results is Dec. 16.

- Virtual training of YMCA swim officials courses is acceptable upon the approval of the trainer by the Chair of the YMCA Swim Officials Committee, <u>Eddie Hughes</u>.
