The meeting's "priority" topic was planning for the Saturday, January 28, 2023, Y State meet. The following is the summary of the discussion.

Projected number of attendees and officials

Each of the teams in attendance updated their projected number of swimmers for the Y State Champs meet. The projection of 390 will be used for planning purposes until the entries are submitted in mid-January. (Note – NorthShore joined the meeting following this discussion and did not get an opportunity to provide projections. An email will be sent to Coach Branden Hinckley to see if he has projections to add.)

Although the teams report 31 officials, there is a concern there will be around ½ that number at the meet. This is based on prior Y State meets where half of the registered officials attended. Of the 31, eleven are new officials who will have helped at only a couple of meets. Given their limited experience staffing two pools will be a challenge. Dave Baer and Linda Vicik will look at consolidating events by age and gender so the meet can be operated in one pool. A single pool would allow the staffing of the pool with less officials. Dave and Linda will also look at ways of keeping the length of the meet around 5 hours.

Sanctioning of the meet

The teams discussed the options of not seeking YMCA Championship sanction. Following the discussion, the teams decided to request a YMCA Championship sanction to allow swimmers with national cuts who can't/don't make it to the regional meet in Boise will still be eligible to attend for spring nationals in North Carolina.

Planning for Y State - requirements, tasks, and timeline

The summary of the discussion is:

- Hold a one-day Y Sanction Championship in a Timed Final format on Saturday, January 28, 2023.
- Participation in two Y meets is required to attend Y State.
- Must have meet times. NTs will not be accepted for Y State.
- Coaches will certify each swimmer has practiced starts and can complete the length of events.
- Coaches to submit names of swimmer that may need to be assigned to outside lanes in order to use ladders to climb out of pool (as KCAC pool has a approximately 2 foot space between pool deck and water.)
- Number of events 3 individuals/ 2 relays
 - There are no time standards for this meet except for the following:
 - At the 12-13-22 PSSA meeting (by a vote of 8 to 2) the teams chose to set time standards for 200 or longer events.

Timeline:

- Tuesday, 1-17-23, by 9 p.m. the following items will be due:
 - Entries
 - Meet Declaration Form that includes \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 in liability insurance coverage and damage claim waiver,
 - The names of graduating seniors,
 - National qualifiers,
 - o Frank Toles nominees (instructions will be in meet announcement.)
 - The teams Core Values nominees. Only 4 per team.
- Monday 1-23-23, by 5 p.m. will send psych sheet and events by swimmer report to teams.
- Wednesday, 1-25-23, by 5 p.m. send finalized heat sheet to teams.
