Welcome, Introductions, and review of April 12, 2022, notes

Nicole, PSSA President, opened the meeting, welcomed everyone, especially Blake who is back as Auburn coach. She asked if there were any questions about the April 12th notes. There were not any questions about the notes.

As for updates, Blake explained that Auburn will be practicing over the summer and will join competition starting in the fall. Aleia said Gordon is still working on hosting a meet at Puyallup High School for the southern teams.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u>

Marylin reviewed the rebates for the 2021-22 fall season. The rebate is based on:

- \$5 rebate for each swimmer who participated in a PSSA hosted meet.
- \$15 rebate per swimmer who participated in the Y State meet.
- \$50 per team that registered their team with the National Y Competitive Swimming and Diving Program.
- Based on these factors the total rebate is \$4,920 for the following teams (details attached):

 Skagit - \$790
 Whatcom - \$610
 Bremerton - \$1,365
 Grays Harbor - \$80
 Lakewood - \$125
 Morgan - \$735
 Olympia - \$795
 Mel Korum - 50
 Tom Taylor - 320

Marilyn also explained that revenue generated during the 2021-22 Fall season was \$7,840 (\$2,080 by Bremerton and \$5,760 for the Y State meet.)

2022 Spring/Summer Season:

The group reviewed the spring/summer schedule developed at the May meeting to check for any changes or updates. Jan explained disappointment by a number of her parents because the majority of meets are scheduled for Sundays. It was acknowledged these dates were the ones the branches were willing to make available for the spring/summer series. Hopefully, PSSA will be able to return to Saturdays in the fall

Jan clarified the July 30th meet will be for the southern teams. Also added to the schedule the meet that will be hosted by Gordon.
