YMCA National Long Course Championship Meet

The 2024 YMCA National Long Course Championship Meet is July 30 – August 3 in Ocala, Florida.

- Entry Deadline July 22 at 9:00 pm Eastern Time.
- Senior Recognition <u>submissions</u> due July 19.
- Moment of Remembrance submit by July 19.
- Athlete Volunteers (Devotions, National Anthem) applications due July 22.
- Athlete Travel Assistance <u>applications</u> due July 22.
- State Sign Carriers applications due July 22. First come-first served by state.
- **CEO Declarations** and **Coach/Parent/Adult Athlete Attestations** due July 26. <u>IMPORTANT</u> <u>NOTE</u>: For Parent, Adult Athlete and Coach Attestations, *please* ask them to use the same exact name on the attestation that is used on the meet entry so that there is no delay at check-in for unsubmitted attestations.
- **NEW Online Coaches Meeting** Wednesday, July 24 at 8:00 pm Eastern Time. This is THE general coaches meeting for the meet. The only onsite coaches meeting will be for new coaches attending YMCA Nationals for the first time. The general coaches meeting will be recorded and posted on the meet site. Find the Microsoft Teams link to the meeting on the meet site.
- **Insurance Certificates** must be up-to-date and on file with Y-USA by July 26. Check the current list here. Note that all certificates must be uploaded by your YMCA's CEO or MOYP Administrator. E-mailed or paper copies cannot be accepted.
- **Timers and Officials NEEDED**. Because ten (10) competition lanes will be used, there is a greater need for Timers especially. Those who work at least five sessions receive spectator access for the balance of the meet. Encourage your parents to sign up early in order to secure their spots and to complete the volunteer requirements for national events. Find information and sign-up forms here.
 - There are 150 timer slots between Prelims, Finals and Time Trials. In order to fill all slots, teams are asked to provide timers based on the number of swimmers they have competing in the meet:
 - 50+ swimmers 10 Timer slots
 - 40-49 swimmers 7 Timer slots
 - 30-39 swimmers 5 Timer slots
 - 10-29 swimmers 3 Timer slots



- **NEW Spectator Ticket Sales** will be purchased online ONLY. The HomeTown Tickets link will be posted to the meet site. All sales are online. There will be no on-site vendor for spectator tickets. Wristbands, required for admission, may be picked up at the aquatic center.

2024 YMCA Annual Tom Warrick Virtual Invitational
